Ngong Ping 360 to commence Rope Replacement Project on 9 January 2017

(Hong Kong, 23 December 2016) At a press conference on 9 November this year, Ngong Ping 360 announced the arrangements for its rope replacement project. Following coordination with overseas rope experts since 2014, and consultation with relevant government departments and the overseas rope manufacturer, the project is now scheduled to start on 9 January 2017 and is targeted for completion in June 2017.

During the project, the cable car service will be closed temporarily but Ngong Ping Village will remain open and form the backdrop for lion dance performances during the Lunar New Year celebrations. Guests will be able to purchase our 360 Lantau Land and Sea Guided Tour at a promotional price of HK\$150 per person at the Tung Chung Cable Car Terminal to visit Ngong Ping Village, the Big Buddha, Po Lin Monastery and Tai O Fishing Village by our coach and enjoy the Tai O boat excursion. Guests can also take other modes of transport to Ngong Ping Village. To ensure public safety and facilitate the project's requirements, the Ngong Ping Rescue Trail will not be open to the public during the replacement period.

We at Ngong Ping 360 would like to show our appreciation for our guests' continuous support. From 1 December 2016 until 8 January 2017, Hong Kong citizens purchasing round-trip cable car tickets or packages at regular prices will be offered one discount card. They will be able to use the card to join the 360 Lantau Land and Sea Guided Tour at the discounted price of HK\$100 during the rope replacement period; and/or within the first month after reopening, redeem one individual 360 Annual Pass at a preferential price of HK\$100 for unlimited cable car rides (Standard Cabin) in 2017.

Dr Stella Kwan, Managing Director of Ngong Ping 360, said that "the company pays great attention to the safety of the cable car system and has always invested significant amounts of resources in maintenance to provide guests with safe and comfortable cable car journeys. To avoid the typhoon season hampering project progress and secure the safety of maintenance

staff, it is necessary that the project be carried out during the Lunar New Year period. Ngong Ping 360 sincerely apologises to any affected guests, the public and stakeholders. We look forward to providing exceptional travel experiences for guests on completion of the project”.

As an important tourist attraction located on Lantau Island in Hong Kong, Ngong Ping 360 offers an exciting opportunity for guests to experience a unique natural and cultural experience. The Ngong Ping Cable Car stretches 5.7 km from Tung Chung to Ngong Ping. Guests can visit the Chinese architecturally designed Ngong Ping Village, where they can enjoy a range of dining, shopping and entertainment options and culturally themed attractions, including Stage 360, Motion 360 and Walking with Buddha.

The Ngong Ping Cable Car is a rare example of a bi-cable gondola circulating lift system, and is also the longest aerial cable car of its kind in Asia. It offers a visually spectacular 25-minute journey with panoramic views of the flora and fauna of North Lantau Country Park, Tung Chung Bay and the Hong Kong International Airport.

Ngong Ping 360 received the CILT Award 2013 – Enterprise Award presented by the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport in Hong Kong (CILTHK) in 2014. It was also selected as one of the “Cable cars: 10 amazing rides around the world” in the same year by The Daily Telegraph in the UK and named as amongst “10 of the world’s most amazing cable car experiences” by CNN.com in the USA in 2015.
